URBAN CLIMATE ACTION TO ADVANCE NDC IMPLEMENTATION: A dialogue between Latin American local and national government representatives

THEME

Cities are significant contributors to climate change; thus urban climate actions are fundamental to reach the Paris Agreement and the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs). However, there is little coordination between national and sub-national governments, particularly in Latin America, to guide and monitor the implementation of NDCs in local authorities. In this session, national and sub-national representatives from Colombia, Mexico and Peru will discuss how to advance NDC implementation through collaboration.

This event will:

- Foster dialogue between national and local governments on how to identify, implement and report on cities' actions that contribute to the NDCs
- Identify a roll for civil society organizations in assisting cities to deliver on the NDCs
- Offer inspiring examples of urban climate action that can encourage raising NDC ambitions
