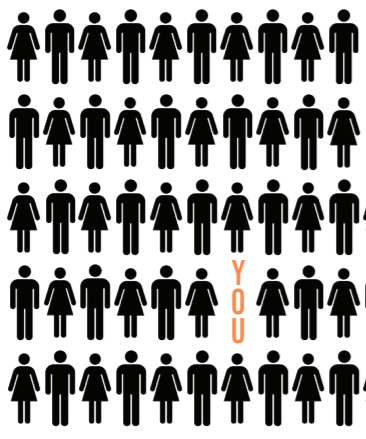

### Where postcards are coming from and where they're going

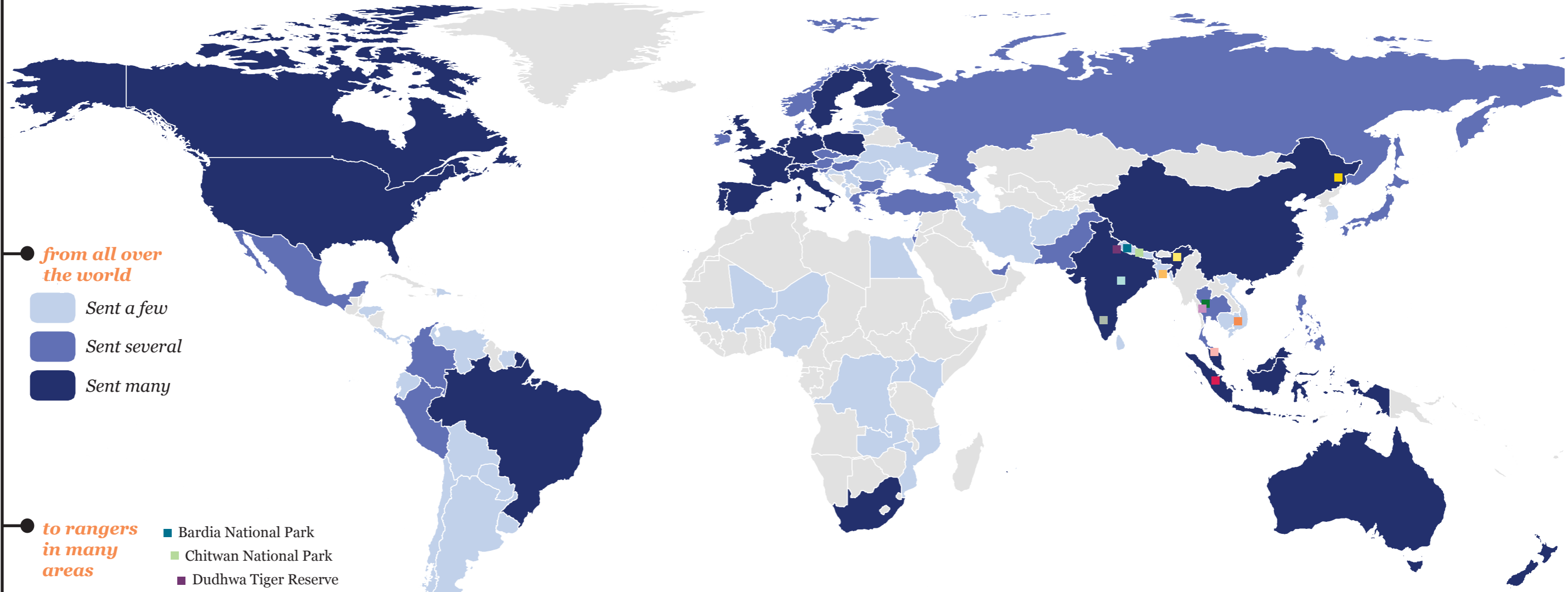
On July 31st 2012, World Ranger Day, the WWF Tigers Alive Initiative launched *Cards4Tigers*, an action aimed at showing support and appreciation for the forest guards, park wardens and field enforcement officers who work tirelessly under harsh conditions on the frontlines of conservation to keep tigers safe. Since then over 100,000 postcards and e-cards have been mailed from all over the world to rangers in Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and Nepal.
